2. In America last week, a guy broke his own record by eating 70 hot dogs in 10 minutes. How long did it take him, on average, to eat one hot dog? (Answer to 2 decimal places)?

3. A special course is being run to teach pet-owners first aid for their pets. It costs \$80 for the 2½-hour course. If there are half a dozen students at the course, how much money is collected?

4. Computer experts believe that children should limit "screen time" to less than 2 hours per day. What percentage of the 14-hour waking time in a child's waking day is that?



5. Of the 200 children who dressed up in their favourite superhero costumes at a superhero exhibition in Melbourne last week, 42% were dressed up as Superman. How many Superman costumes were there altogether?

6. In a footy tipping contest, the leader is Jon Ralph, who has picked 97 winners. Coming last is our Prime Minister, Malcolm Turnbull, who has picked only 85 winners. If the PM picks 2 more winners each week than Jon Ralph, how many weeks will it be before the PM gets ahead of John Ralph's winner picks?



7. Jazz Ballet lessons for children aged between 4 and 11 years old cost \$42.50 for a 10-lesson term. What is the cost for a full 4-term year?

8. The Melbourne Zoo has a new baby elephant, but she's very sick. The zoo has 4 vets looking after her all day, every day. How many hours per day does each vet work, if they all work equal time?



9. Open-Ended Question: In the pet shop, there are twice as many puppies for sale as kittens. If puppies sell for \$48 each and kittens sell for \$39 each, how much can the pet shop owner receive for selling all of these puppies and kittens? Give at least 3 different answers.
